**PRESS RELEASE: droidcon Berlin 2017**

**Berlin, September 2**

The 9<sup>th</sup> edition of Europe's leading independent Android developer conference [droidcon Berlin](#) will take place on September, 3-5 in the CityCube Berlin, Hall A. For the the first time droidcon will be a part of the [IFA](#), one of the world's largest trade shows for consumer electronics. More than 1000 developers and experts are expected to attend the conference and explore all facets of the Android software ecosystem.

droidcon Berlin kicks off on Sunday, September 3 with a traditional Barcamp day organized by Danny Preussler, Nebojsa Bozic and Friedger Müffke. In the following two days the conference presents keynote talks by Android advocate and expert Chiu-Ki Chan and Ame Elliott. The variety of topics ranges from Android architecture to Internet of Things and UX/UI design and is discussed

in over 60 sessions, keynotes and workshops. In total, there are seven tracks on four different stages.

### **Barcamp day**

The Barcamp day consisted of [Barcamp](#) and a panel discussion on data persistence. Barcamp, one of the interactive parts of the three-day program, was organized by Danny Preussler, Nebojsa Bozic and Friedger Müffke who supported the event in the previous years as well. This year participants had a chance to actively shape the conference program by presenting their topics to the audience and picking the ones that eventually made it to the final Barcamp session schedule.

Moreover, an informal [panel discussion](#) on data persistence took place in the afternoon that featured Christian Melchior (Android Team Lead at Realm), Florina Muntenescu (Android Developer Advocate at Google), Leandro Favarin (Lead Android Engineer at Blinkist) and Markus Junginger (CTO at ObjectBox). Overall, over 400 attendees participated in the Barcamp activities.

### **Keynotes and program highlights for September 4-5**

The two day Android conference program covers the latest tendencies and the newest technologies in the mobile software development. In particular, the conference sessions are spread over following conference tracks: APIs, Best Practices / Code Quality, Design / UI/UX, Internet of Things, Languages, Android Architecture, and Android Game Development and Virtual Reality. Highlights of the developer conference are, among others, keynote talks by [Chiu-Ki Chan](#), who will talk about her passion for sharing Android expert knowledge, and [Ame Elliott](#), who will provide insights into UX security in IoT and beyond. In addition to that Svetlana Isakova will elaborate on "[Kotlin Coroutines](#)", Joe Birch will talk about crafting UI with optimism in "[For optimists, our UI is pretty pessimistic](#)", Xavier F. Gouchet will discuss Mutation testing for Android apps in "[Genetically modified tests](#)" and Danny Preussler will review "[The power of Kotlin for your tests](#)". droidcon Berlin is part of the global droidcon community with around 20 droidcons worldwide in 2016. The idea behind droidcon is to support the Android platform and create a strong network for developers and companies.
